AGES: 3-12 years (Private and Public schools)

HOSTED AT: Urban Life Church MIDRAND

- All mornings will follow a fun and dynamic program where volunteers facilitate creative activities, dramas, games, songs and crafts that the children get to participate in until 13:00.
- Thereafter, volunteers will rotate in facilitating kids' care for full day packages – an afternoon of supervised free play with fun options to choose from!

PACKAGES TO CHOOSE FROM

HALF DAY - 1 SNACK PROVIDED

08H00 – 13H00 @ R100-00 per child per day.

FULL DAY -- 2 SNACKS PROVIDED

08H00 – 17H00 @ R150-00 per child per day.

FAMILY DISCOUNT

Families with more than one child get a **15% discount** on the total amount due.

THINGS TO BRING

- A packed lunch box for each of your children every day!
- A backpack with a labelled hat and sunblock inside.

THINGS NOT TO BRING

- NO technology (cell phones, tablets or speakers)
- NO valuables or toys – There will be plenty of fun to be had!
- NO sweets, chips or cold drinks. We will have a permanent water station available for your children to stay hydrated.

Will my children be safe?

- Your children's safety and your peace of mind is a priority to us! We have made every effort to ensure that all systems we use and the environments your children will be in are safe and secure.

Who will look after my children?

- Volunteers will be giving up their free time to serve and care for your children. These volunteers will be guided and supported by leaders, interns and Urban Life Church staff members respectively.

What if my children get sick or hurt at Holiday Club?

- There will be a sickroom for children who may need to rest during the day. They will be supervised by a qualified first-aider. Please take note that, should your child(ren) need medical attention or need to be hospitalized, we will contact you first before any further steps are taken to care for your child. (See indemnity form for more details regarding this.)
- If your child gets sick during the Holiday Club week, please let them stay at home until they are back to full health and can join the fun again.

What if my child(ren) need to take a nap during the day?

- For young children between the ages of 3-5, we offer a midday nap time for them.

What if I have a child(ren) who is younger than 3 years old?

- Unfortunately, we will not take any children under the age of 3 as the week is run on a volunteer basis and these volunteers may not be professionally trained to look after younger children for a long period of time.

What if I'd like to get involved and volunteer at Holiday Club?

- If you would like to get involved at Holiday Club, please notify a volunteer at the Popup Stand on Sunday. Once you have done this, you will be contacted by someone from the Urban Life team. Alternatively, you could email lauren@urbanlife.org.za

What will my child(ren) be learning?

- This year our theme is Come One, Come All. Each day will be based on biblical truths using different aspect of the circus to theme each lesson. We will teach that God has big dreams and plans for our lives. God created us wonderfully and uniquely and that ALL people are invited into the family of God.

What if my family is not Christian?

- We value people and believe that you can belong before you believe! Anyone is welcome!

What if my children can only attend a few days of the Holiday Club week?

- We've got your back! There are Single Day Passes to choose from when you register for both Half Day and Full Day packages.

What if I can't afford to send my children to Holiday Club?

- There are sponsorships available. Please register your child(ren) at the Popup Stand on Sunday and be sure to indicate on the form how much you're able to contribute towards the grand total.

Are my children allowed to bring a friend?

- ABSOLUTELY. The more, the merrier! Just make sure that you get their parents to register them before registrations close. (30 June 2019)

What time may I drop my children off and what happens if I am late to fetch them?

- You are welcome to drop your children off anytime from 07H00 each morning. The official program starts at 08H00.
- Parents/guardians who run late in the afternoons will have to pay a fee of R100-00 for every 15min past 17H00.
